# **Program Overview**

Under the College to Corporate (C2C) Program, IIT Bombay has designed **six short courses** to acquire important **professional skills.** In the first semester, i.e. from September to November 2018, IIT Bombay offered three courses across the country. We got an overwhelming response from various institutions and states. There were about 4000 students who participated in these courses. Last semester, we conducted three courses - Soft Skills, Workplace Communication, and Effective use of IT for Professional Activities.

We will now conduct three courses for this semester-English for Oral Communication, Financial Literacy, and Handling Large Projects. For details, please check the 'course content'. These courses under the C2C program will be useful to students from any discipline, who aspire to join the corporate world. These will help them learn about corporate expectations and skills required to perform well in the job. These courses are primarily targeted at the final / pre-final year students.

Courses under this program will be conducted using a **Blended MOOCs** approach, which combines the advantages of **online learning** and **face-to-face (F2F)** interactions. Learners will carry out online activities and assessments on the <a href="https://literactions.com/literact

#### **Course duration and efforts**

The course content is designed for duration of **four weeks**, with 6-8 hours of effort per week. One of these courses is designed as the foundation course - `English for oral communication'.

This course will be conducted over a longer duration, covering the content at a reduced pace.

- Participants who successfully complete a course will get an online honour code certificate for that course from IITBombayX.
- Participants who successfully complete all six courses (first semester and second semester) will additionally get an honour code certificate for the entire C2C program.
